#### Academic Responsibilities

- Teach 6th, 7th, and 8th grade Math classes, setting high expectations and creating relevant, standards-based lessons.
- Attend regularly scheduled meetings with administration, whole faculty, and grade-level teams.
- Maintain regular contact with parents of students of all ability levels to communicate academic strengths and challenges.
- Use current instructional technologies effectively.
- Work with the Student Support Team to arrange and implement necessary student accommodations.
- Mentor a Teaching Fellow through observation, co-teaching, and co-planning.

#### Proctoring Responsibilities

- Supervise students in various activities for 1 period per day.
- Once per week, moderate or coach in the extended day program until 5 p.m.
- Once per week, proctor the evening study program from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

#### Required Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Education or a related field.
- Experience teaching Math and/or Science.
- Experience teaching students from underserved backgrounds.

#### Desired Qualifications

- Master's degree in Education or a related field.
- Experience teaching elementary or middle school Math.
- Familiarity with Jesuit education and/or the Nativity model.
