



Position: Part-Time Math Teacher

About us: Nativity Preparatory School of Boston is a tuition-free, Jesuit middle school serving boys from Boston families of economic need. Through small classes, strong relationships, an extended school day, and long-term graduate support, Nativity prepares students for success in high school, college, and beyond. Our community is rooted in high expectations, care for the whole student, and a deep commitment to helping young men grow academically, socially, spiritually, and personally.

Position Overview: Nativity Prep is seeking a part-time Math Teacher to join our faculty for the upcoming school year. This position is ideal for an educator who is passionate about teaching math, enjoys working with middle school students, and is excited to be part of a mission-driven school community.

The Part-Time Math Teacher will teach math classes during the first half of the school day, with a typical schedule of approximately **7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**, Monday through Friday, from **September through June**. The teacher will also be expected to participate in orientation and preparation activities in August.

The teacher will work with small groups of students, typically teaching about half of a grade-level class, approximately 10 students or fewer depending on student needs and math placement. The ideal candidate will be able to provide strong instruction, build meaningful relationships with students, and support a range of learners within a small classroom setting.

Key Responsibilities:

The Part-Time Math Teacher will:

- Teach engaging, standards-aligned math lessons to middle school students during the morning portion of the school day.
- Support the implementation of Nativity Prep's math curriculum in collaboration with the lead math teacher and school leadership.
- Utilize a variety of instructional strategies to promote student understanding, problem-solving, confidence, and engagement in math.
- Differentiate instruction to meet the needs of students at varying skill levels and provide appropriate support and challenge.
- Foster a collaborative, structured, and inclusive classroom environment where students feel supported, encouraged, and held to high expectations.
- Assess student learning through classwork, formative assessments, and other measures, and provide timely feedback to support student growth.
- Communicate regularly with students, families, colleagues, and administrators regarding student progress, needs, and successes.
- Collaborate with colleagues to align instruction, share best practices, and support consistency across the math program.



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- Participate in orientation, school meetings, and professional development opportunities as appropriate for the role.

Qualifications:

Required qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required.
- Experience teaching math at the middle school or high school level.
- Strong classroom management and relationship-building skills.
- Ability to teach math clearly, patiently, and effectively to students with a range of learning needs.
- Commitment to the mission of Nativity Prep and to the education of young boys from low-income families.
- Strong communication, organization, and collaboration skills.

Preferred qualifications:

- Math licensure preferred.
- Master's degree preferred.
- Experience teaching Algebra I or strong comfort with Algebra I content.
- Experience differentiating instruction for small groups of students is preferred.
